CONDITIONS FOR AN ENTRY VISA INTO CAMEROON
OPENING HOURS : DEPOSITION OF APPLICATIONS : 9 :30 TO 12 :30
WITHDRAWAL OF DOCUMENTS : 2 :30 p.m to 4 : 30 p.m

I - GENERAL

- 1. A form carefully completed, dated and signed by the applicant.**
- 2. Two recent passport-size photographs with name (s) and surname (s) at the back.**
- 3. A national passport or another travel document valid for at least six months upon return.**
- 4. An international Certificate of Vaccination - Vaccine required : yellow fever.**
- 5. Residence permits for foreigners in Switzerland, or work permit for border residents.**
- 6. A stamped return envelope recommended.**
- 7. A return plane ticket or a flight confirmation.**
- 8. Fees payable to the chancery office, through mailing or money order to the Cameroon Embassy in Bern (29, brunnadernrain, CH 3006 Bern) : CHF 138. -from 1 day to 90 days (3 months) ; CHF 276. - from 91 days to 180 days (6 months).**

II - FOR STAFF OF DIPLOMATIC MISSIONS AND INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS

- 1. A valid Passport**
- 2. A verbal note and a mission order**
- 3. Two recent passport-size photographs**

III - BUSINESS MEN

- 1. Meet the requirements of I**
- 2. Letter of recommendation from the parent company supporting all travel and accommodation expenses of the person (s) in Cameroon, and vouching for good behaviour.**

IV - FAMILY VISITS AND FRIENDSHIP

- 1. Meet the requirements of I.**
- 2. Certificate of accommodation and support established by the host and authenticated by Cameroonian authorities at the place of destination.**

- ❖ **Foreigners married to Cameroonians must submit a copy of the marriage certificate or family book instead of a certificate accomodation.**
- ❖ **Minors travelling alone or with one parent must submit a notorized parental authorization by authorities at the communal place of residence.**

V – TOURISTS

- 1. Meet the requirements of I**
- 2. Bank certificate confirming that the person (s) is able to meet his travel and accomodation expenses, or a recent bank statement.**
- 3. A hotel reservation.**

VI – FOR ALL PERSONS INVITED BY THE CAMEROONIAN AUTHORITIES

- 1. Meet the requirements of I**
- 2. Present the letter of invitation.**

VII – TRANSIT VISA

- 1. Meet the requirements of I**
- 2. Present the passport with the visa of the country of destination.**

VIII – LONG STAY VISA

- 1. Meet the requirements of I**
- 2. File the guarantee of return.**
- 3. Produce an employment contract stamped by the Ministry of Labour, for foreigners wishing to engage in salarised activity in Cameroon.**
- 4. Produce an authorization to practice a liberal profession or to promote an agricultural, pastoral, industrial, commercial, artistic or otherwise activity, issued by the competent authorities, where such authorization is required.**
- 5. Submit a document justifying the conjugal link for the spouse, or parental link for the minor children.**
- 6. Submit a certificate of registration or renewal of registration issued by the authorities of the establishment for students, or a document of internship for trainees or interns.**
